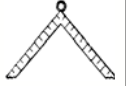

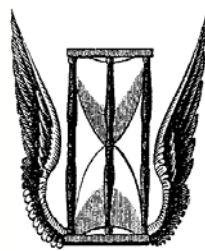

The services we provide are fingerprinting, video taping, and occasionally, DNA swabbing and dental molds. This information is then given to the parents which they could give to authorities in the event their child becomes missing.

Keep ME Warm

The Keep ME Warm project was started by Gov. Baldacci three years ago and which we participated in as a lodge last year. This is a 4-day intensive community service project that sends volunteer teams to "winterize" homes for 3,000 of Maine's low income senior and disabled homeowners.

Volunteers install energy conservation and efficiency products to reduce energy use, energy bills, winter drafts, and to improve comfort.

Last year, 1,500 volunteers winterized homes for 2,100 low-income Maine homeowners. The goal this year is to winterize 3,000 homes.

This year, as a lodge, we have committed to participate 2 of the 4 days; Friday October 20th and Sunday, October 22nd. We will be given names of homeowners in the towns of Mechanic Falls, Minot & Poland who have been determined by the State as needing assis-

tance.

Last year we had 4 masons who donated their time in this worthwhile task. This year, we are looking for double that. If you are available for one or both of the days listed above, please call Rick Bergeron (998-5365) for more information.

All weatherization items have been donated by companies and will be supplied. All you need bring is yourself. Please help us help the people in our communities who will have a difficult time keeping their homes warm this year.
